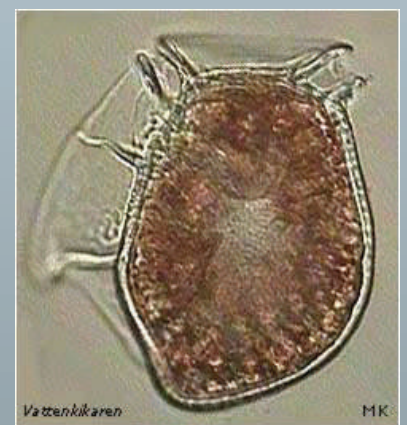
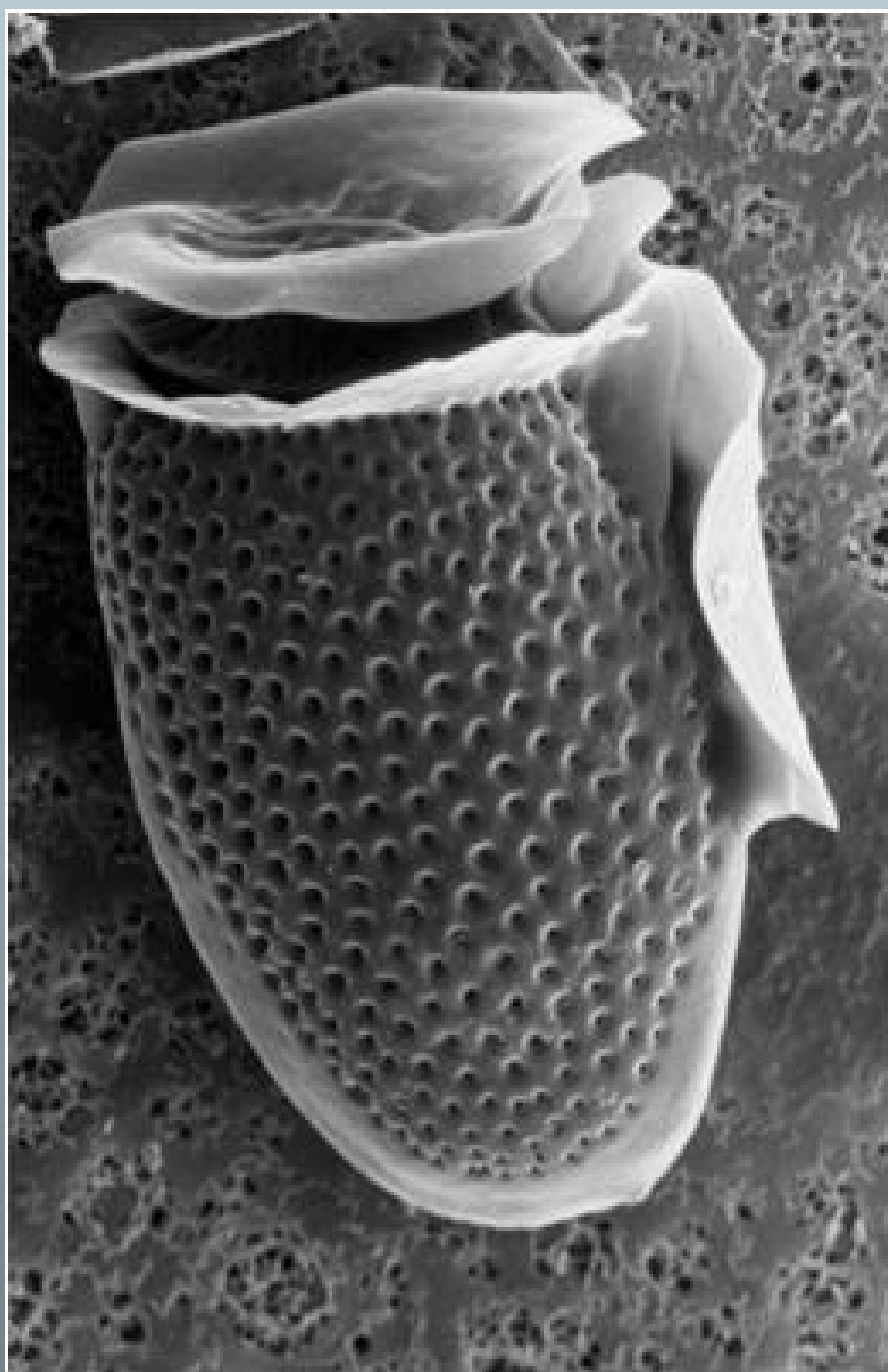


Emerging Biotoxins in Washington Waters
